


Baby Check App: How To Use



This app has been designed to help parents and carers decide whether their baby needs a doctor. Baby Check contains 19 simple checks which test for different symptoms or signs of illness. The app is not designed to replace a parent or carer's judgement. If the check provides a low score but they are still worried, they should be encouraged to seek advice from a medical professional.



1. After viewing the **Introduction** screen press **BEGIN**. You will be asked if the baby has any of the 7 symptoms displayed on screen.



2. If you press **YES**, the baby may be seriously ill and should be seen by a doctor straight away. A prompt will appear to dial 999.







3. If you press **NO** you will be taken to the main Baby Check page. Here you can learn more about how to use the app, when to use it and how it works. Read all sections before beginning the check. When ready click on **Start The Check**.



4. You will be taken through a series of checks. Tap the button that best answers the question. Each time you answer you will automatically be taken to the next check. **Press the back arrow button to return to the previous page.**



5. On completion a score will be shown: **0-7** the baby is a little unwell and may not need medical attention; **8-12** the baby is unwell and you may wish to consult a doctor; **13-19** the baby is ill and you should contact the doctor; **20+** means baby is seriously ill and must be seen straight away.
