5. On completion a score will be shown: 0-7 the baby is a little unwell and may not need medical attention; 8-12 the baby is unwell and you may wish to consult a doctor; 13-19 the baby is ill and you should contact the doctor; 20+ means baby is seriously ill and must be seen straight away.
